

2021 allocation of mackerel¹

Marine Scotland will make the following special allocations from Scotland's EQ share:

North Sea handline mackerel fishery: 1,000 tonnes will be allocated for landings by vessels fishing in the 10mu Pool.

The amount will be shared among separately managed sub-fisheries in the Moray Firth, Shetland, Orkney and IVb.

Scotland will make a Special Allocation for the following quotas and amounts for the 10mu Pool:

NS Mackerel: 50 tonnes

And finally, the 10mu pool was allocated of 16 tonnes of quota carried forwards from 2020.
