What we propose:

Prohibition on berried female lobster

- · Will deliver improvements to the reproductive health of lobster stocks.
- · Will secure consistency with other areas.
- · Will be kept under review and monitored along with fishers.

© Controls on 'supercrabber' activity in inshore waters

- Affects a small number of boats who can typically work on and offshore.
- · Prevents nomadic vessels undermining voluntary agreements.
- · A number of approaches are open to us.
- Our chosen approach will be kept under review and monitored.

₱ Progression of voluntary sustainability-focussed initiatives through the RIFG

- Allows us to test approaches that may ultimately become policy.
- Allows flexibility to determine how best to realise our regional approach
- Utilises the RIFG project framework to progress projects for the common good.





